















Lesser Penalties

When the Bible says "they shall be cut off in the sight of the children of their people...He shall bear his iniquity" it is indicating a greater punishment than "he shall bear his iniquities". Note verses 17, 18, and 19. The combination of the two phrases is another way of saying "put to death." "Shall bear his iniquities" alone means that his punishment is decided by the courts if God does not specifically say what the punishment is.
